Entrants must be aged 18-30, and live, work, or attend school in Pierce County. County employees and their immediate family are not eligible. Entries must be provided in digital form (.jpg preferred) and be returned with the contest entry form. The winning designer will be asked to provide their work as a scalable vector graphic, Illustrator preferred. All entrants should be advised their submittals will become public record, and be subject to disclosure. All entries must be received by 4:30pm, October 8, 2013.
