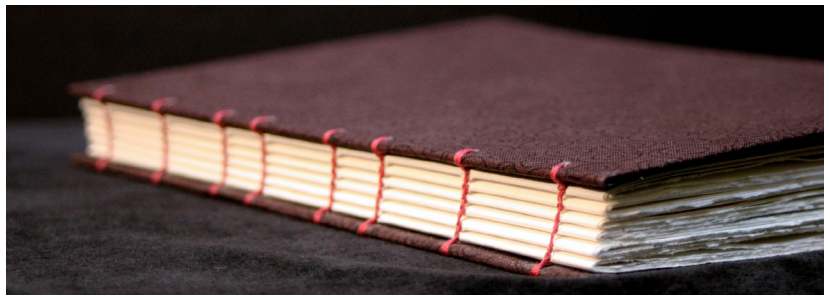


Create a Hand-Sewn Journal / Sketchbook
