Rigoni is an “emerging earthscape art photographer dedicated to creating subjective and interpretive images of our shared American landscape.”



His exhibition, titled *Oxidized!*, presents “oxidized metals from the Mojave— rusted cans, discarded bolts, spiraling culverts, and other metallic objects — which seem annihilated by the gritty red rust of time. These remnants have been ‘born again’ thru contemporary art photographs using light, textures & micro-details, revealing beautiful metals that supported desert pioneers as they pursued life, love and riches in this unforgiving environment.”
