

## Make Way: Queer Photography, Identity, and You

This two-part interactive workshop—led by Seattle-based artist Steven Miller— asks: What does it mean to document our lives through photography, and how do we want to see our LGBTQIA+ community represented?

The first session leads participants through a visual tour of queer photography, followed by a take-home assignment that will prepare attendees for the interactive portion of the workshop, where they will learn how to produce a cyanotype of their own.
